#### **Step 1: How do I register for an Oracle Academy Institutional membership?**

1. Go to [www.oracle.com/academy](http://www.oracle.com/academy) - Oracle Academy Website
2. Click Membership
3. Click Join Today or Join Oracle Academy
4. Scroll down the page and Click Institutional members join here
5. Click on Create Account, to create an Oracle Account.
6. Complete the form and Click Create Account.
7. You will see a page titled "Your Account Has Been Create" Click Continue
8. Sign into your Oracle Account: Username: Is your Email/ Password: Is the password you just created for the Oracle Account

9. You should now be in the Membership Registration and Ordering Page. Scroll Down the page and Click on Register My Institution
10. Search for your institution: Your school is in our system- search by this postal code
11. Your institution should be listed on the page, Click on your institution name (NOTE: If the address is incorrect, you will have a chance to correct it later).
12. Complete the form and Click Next.
13. Accept Oracle Academy Institutional Membership agreement. An authorized legal signature is required (usually from your principal). Click Next
14. Review your Institution and your information. Click Submit Registration to complete your institutional membership registration.

WAITING TIME: It will take at least 3 days to create your institutional membership account. If your principal does not click on the email that was sent by system so he/she can accept the agreement, it will take more than 3 days (please follow up). Once, your institutional membership account is created, you can ENROLL in the course. If 3 days has passed and you have not heard anything from Oracle Academy – PLEASE contact Kameron Vachuska at 916-315-5949.

## Step 2: How do I enroll for training (Institutional Members Only)?

1. Once your institutional membership account is activated, return to [www.oracle.com/academy](http://www.oracle.com/academy)
2. Click Sign in/Register for Account
3. Click Oracle Academy - NEW
4. Enter your Username and Password
5. You should now be in your Oracle Academy Institution Member Page, on the left side bar, by Training, Click on the down arrow, Select Search and Enroll in Training
6. Scroll and Find: Virtual Instructor Led Training - United States and Canada, United States, Training - J007NAM5\_16, Getting Started with Java Using Alice
7. Click the box to select the training course.
8. Click Enroll.
